Launched in 2021 by **Andy Street CBE** (Mayor of the West Midlands), Reimagining the Region is our network of member organisations who want to see the region thrive.

Members pay an annual membership fee to join the network, which is based on the number of employees within their organisation, ranging from £420 for 1-10 employees to £1,650 for 51+ staff (plus VAT).

Members receive invitations to exclusive receptions in both Westminster and the West Midlands and are also given the opportunity to participate on our panels, steering group discussions as well as provide thought leadership for our primary areas of research interest.
